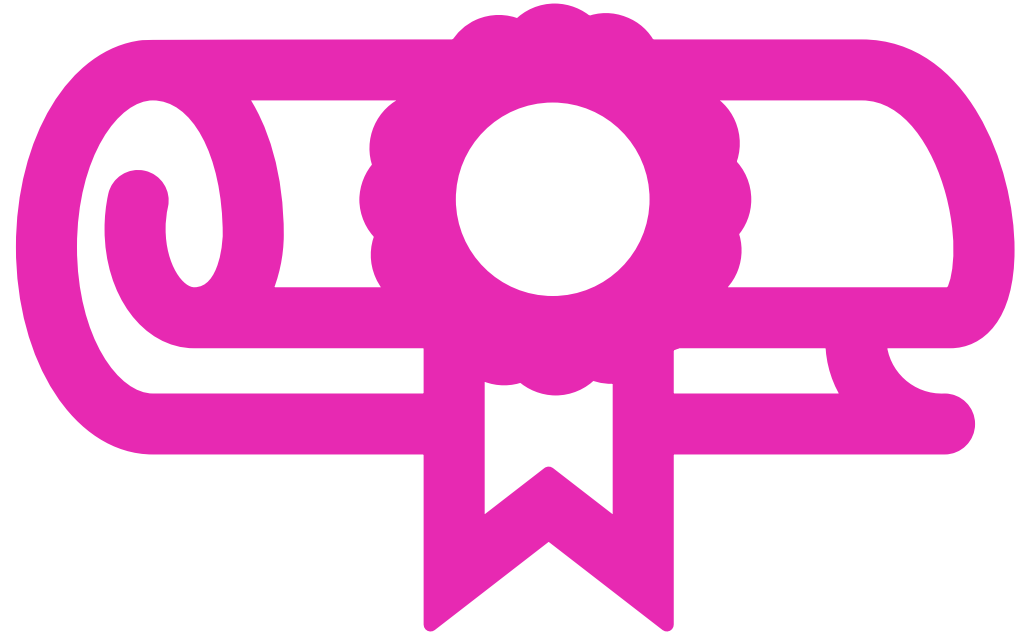
# How does the funding work?

- Students studying an eligible non-Bachelor degree course are eligible for funding up to \$15,000.
- Additionally, candidates approved to participate in the Program may also be eligible for a resources grant of up to \$1,000 to support the purchase of study tools.

# Course Type

---

- Education courses Cert IV and above must be delivered by providers listed on the TEQSA National Register and all VET courses must be on the National Register of VET and delivered by a Registered Training Organisation.
